

OUR RESPONSE TO COVID-19

LYHA is preparing a safe, creative, and fun outdoor space in the backyard of our home office's Art Studio.

- Maximum Class size is under 15 campers.
- Weekly camps are limited to the same students all week.
- Parents will be permitted on-site to drop off and pick up only.
- On-site bathroom and multiple hand washing facilities, plenty of hand sanitizer, and enough room outside to spread out and create.
- We are outside the entire day. It will be optional for all campers and staff to wear a mask outside. Please note: if conditions worsen and there is more spread in the community, we will put the masks back on. All students and staff will wear masks when inside the studio with others.
- ALL campers must show proof of a NEGATIVE FDA approved antigen test taken within 24 hours of the their first day of camp. If your camper is attending multiple weeks of camp, they must provide proof of a new antigen test each week.

Daily Symptoms Screenings: When you arrive in the morning to our outdoor studio, you will fill out a short health screening and we will take your child's temperature before escorting them into camp.

- Antigen testing is encouraged after engaging in a high exposure activity (sports tournaments, attending public events in crowded venues, etc.)
- We are monitoring and following recommended protocols from The LA County Department of Health, The State of California, CDC, and local officials. We will continue to update you via email (and our webpage) with new information as it is released.
